



1. CALL THE CLINIC FOR AN APPOINTMENT

2. BOOK AN APPOINTMENT FOR YOU AND YOUR PARTNER TO SEE A SPECIALIST
COST: Medicare will pay for some of your specialist consultation. Any tests required will be **bulk billed*** where possible



3. RETURN TO SEE YOUR FERTILITY SPECIALIST
5 weeks after all tests are completed you and your partner will return to see your Specialist, where results will be discussed and a treatment plan made
COST: This specialist consultation will be **bulk billed**



4. BOOK AN APPOINTMENT TO MEET WITH A FERTILITY NURSE
At this consultation a nurse will discuss your treatment plan
COST: This nurse consultation will be **bulk billed***

5. TREATMENT: MEDICATIONS NEED TO BE COLLECTED BEFORE TREATMENT STARTS
COST: There is a clinic fee payable and a medication dispensing fee as per PBS co-payment



6. PROCEDURE DAY: This is the day of your egg collection and your partner may need to produce a semen sample
COST: Your IVF cycle will be **bulk billed***

7. EMBRYO TRANSFER: Should fertilisation occur and embryos develop you will be having an embryo transfer in 2-3 days
COST: Your IVF cycle will be **bulk billed***



8. PREGNANCY TEST
Approximately 14 days after your embryo transfer you will take a pregnancy test
COST: This blood test is **bulk billed***



9. FOLLOW UP WITH YOUR CHOSEN SPECIALIST
This will be for either a pregnancy scan or to plan for future treatment depending upon cycle outcome
COST: This specialist consultation and scan will be **bulk billed***



*It is important to note there are some IVF and FET services that are unable to be bulk billed through Medicare, which includes some medications, dispensing of medication, day surgery fees, some laboratory procedures and a small number of pathology tests.
